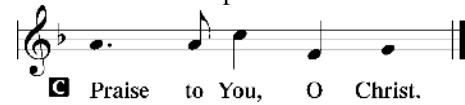
Holy Gospel Matthew 22:15-22

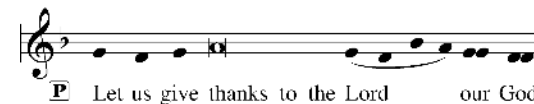
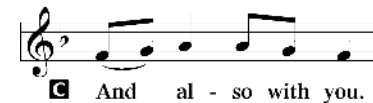
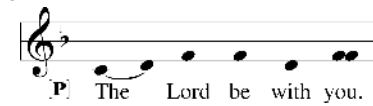
