The Baptism of Aaden Charles Mosser

Baptismal Hymn "Dearest Jesus, We Are Here" verses 1,2,3

LSB 592

P Dearly beloved, Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." In the last chapter of Mark our Lord promises, "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved." And the apostle Peter has written, "Baptism now saves you."

The Word of God also teaches that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ, who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

The pastor makes the sign of the holy cross upon the forehead and heart of each candidate while saying:

P Aaden, receive the sign of the holy cross both upon your **T** forehead and upon your **T** heart to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified.

P Hear the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark.
They brought young children to [Jesus] that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." And He took them up in His arms, put His hands on them, and blessed them.

P This is the Word of the Lord.
C Thanks be to God.

For the baptism of infants and young children the pastor addresses the sponsors:

P It is your task as sponsors to confess with the whole Church the faith in our God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, in whose name these children are to be baptized.

After **this child has** been baptized you are at all times to remember **him** in your prayers, put **him** in mind of **his** Baptism, and, as much as in you lies, give your counsel and aid, especially if **he** should lose **his** parents, that **he** be brought up in the true knowledge and worship of God and be taught the ten Commandments, the Creed, and the Lord's Prayer; and that as **he** grow in years, you

place in **his** hands the Holy Scriptures, bring **him** to the services of God's house, and provide for **his** further instruction in the Christian faith, that **he** come to the Sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood and thus, abiding in **his** baptismal grace and in communion with the Church, **he** may grow up to lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Jesus Christ.

This, then, you intend gladly and willingly to do?

R Yes.

P God enable you both to will and to do this faithful and loving work and with His grace fulfill what we are unable to do.

P In order to implore the blessing of our Lord Jesus Christ upon the gathering of this child into the family of our Father, let us with all the family pray the prayer He gave us.

The pastor places his hands on the head(s) of the candidate(s), and the congregation joins in praying:

C **Our Father who art in heaven,
 hallowed be Thy name,
 Thy kingdom come,
 Thy will be done on earth
 as it is in heaven;
 give us this day our daily bread;
 and forgive us our trespasses
 as we forgive those
 who trespass against us;
 and lead us not into temptation,
 but deliver us from evil.
For Thine is the kingdom
 and the power and the glory
 forever and ever. Amen.**

P The Lord bless us, defend us from all evil, and bring us to everlasting life.

C Amen.

P Because **this child** cannot answer for **himself**, we shall all, together with sponsors and Parents, faithfully speak on **his** behalf in testimony of the forgiveness of sin and the birth of the new life of faith which God our Father bestows in and through Baptism.

P Aaden, do you renounce the devil?

C Yes, I renounce him.

P Do you renounce all his works?

C Yes, I renounce them.

P Do you renounce all his ways?

C Yes, I renounce them.

P Aaden Charles Mosser I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

The pastor places his hands on the head of the newly baptized while saying:

P The almighty God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given you the new birth of water and of the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with His grace to life **T** everlasting.

C Amen.

The pastor may place a white Baptismal cloth on the newly baptized while saying:

P Receive this white cloth to show that you have been clothed with the white robe of Christ's righteousness that covers all your sin.

The pastor may light a baptismal candle from the paschal candle and give it to the newly baptized while saying:

P Receive this burning light to show that you have received Christ who is the Light of the world. Live always in the light of Christ, and be ever watchful for His coming, that you may meet Him with joy and enter with him into the marriage feast of the Lamb in His kingdom, which shall have no end.

P Let us pray.
Almighty and most merciful God and Father, we thank and praise You that You graciously preserve and enlarge Your family and have granted **Aaden** the new birth in Holy Baptism and made **him a** member of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and heirs of Your heavenly kingdom. We humbly implore You that, as **he has** now become Your **child**, You would keep **him** in **his** baptismal grace, that according to Your good pleasure **he** may faithfully grow to lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Your holy name and finally, with all Your saints, obtain the promised inheritance in heaven; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

C Amen.

The baptismal group may turn toward the congregation; a representative of the congregation may say:

A In Holy Baptism God the Father has made you **a member** of His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and heirs with us of all the treasures of heaven in the one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We receive you in Jesus' name as our **brother** in Christ, that together we might hear His Word, receive His gifts, and proclaim the praises of Him who called us out of darkness into His marvelous light.

C Amen. We welcome you into the Lord's family. We receive you as fellow member of the body of Christ, child of the same heavenly Father, to work with us in His kingdom.

P And you, **Aaden**, the Lord bless you in all your ways from this time forth and even forevermore.

C Amen.

Romans 3:19-28

Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. ²⁸For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.
