Five Mile Radius Child Care Population:

Presently, our average child care population is at 74. Given the present U.S. Census demographic data within a five mile radius of Redeemer Church, there are 1,204 children between the ages of 0 to 4 years old. It is also projected that in 2018 there will be 1,363 children between these ages (Decision Insite/Mission Insite, Full Insite Report, 2013, pp. 7-11). This basically represents the total population pool from which our child care draws its enrollment. Presently (2013), within the same five mile radius, there are 361 children enrolled in nursery/preschool (p. 11). Of these 361 children 21% are presently enrolled in our child care. The potential to increase our enrollment exists. Since the child care program has been the principal conduit for baptisms and youth participation in Church activities, then we need to do whatever is necessary to attract more community younger parents to utilize our child care program. Does this mean that we need to replace our present child care facility in order to meet the needs of a potential increase in enrollment and greater your participation in congregation activities?
